#### Pastor's Corner:

Last week we looked at how dangerous it is to look back, studying Lot's wife and how she was lost on the way to salvation when she turned into a pillar of salt. We read in Matthew 6:24, where Jesus teaches, "No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money." This powerful reminder echoes throughout Scripture, finding resonance even in the story of Lot pitching his tent towards Sodom.

Lot's decision to pitch his tent towards Sodom reveals a subtle shift in his priorities. Initially, it may have seemed like a mere geographical choice, but it symbolizes a deeper inclination towards worldly desires. Sodom represented wealth, comfort, and pleasure, drawing Lot's attention away from his devotion to God.

As the narrative unfolds, we witness the consequences of Lot's divided allegiance. His proximity to Sodom exposes him to its corrupting influence, leading to peril for himself and his family. In contrast, Abraham, who chose to dwell in alignment with God's will, experiences blessing and protection.

Similarly, Jesus warns us against divided loyalties. When we allow worldly pursuits to compete for our devotion to God, we risk spiritual compromise and loss. Let us heed Jesus' words and wholeheartedly serve God, prioritizing His kingdom above all else. In doing so, we find true fulfillment and security in Him alone.
