
**Fundraiser:** The church board has requested we start a fundraiser for replacing the sound board and amplifiers. The cost is \$9,540. For more information contact John Christensen.

**Pastor’s Corner:** Dear friends, the Bible declares “Thy way, O God, is in the Sanctuary; who is so great a God as our God” [Psalm 77:13]. When we read scripture, we will discover that the sanctuary is definitely not a human invention, but a concept of heavenly origin. God declared in Exodus 25:8 “And let them make Me a sanctuary; that I may dwell among them”. It is from there that God governs the universe in love. In setting up the sanctuary on earth in the time of Moses, God gave us a pictorial representation of the plan of salvation. However, the Christian church has largely forgotten the sanctuary concept. They see it only as a historical event which is a fatal mistake as the sanctuary discloses the heart of God. The lack of understanding of it could be the reason that people today say that there is no loving God and attribute all evil to the doing of God. EG White said that “God’s people are now to have their eyes fixed on the heavenly sanctuary, where the final ministration of our great High Priest in the work of the judgment is going forward—where He is interceding for His people.” [Evangelism, p. 223] My prayer for you is that you will earnestly study the sanctuary message as for in it lies the key to our salvation.
