
Special Social Event: On Sabbath, February 18th join us for vespers followed by a social event starting at 6:00 pm.

Most of us want to make sure we get to go. But sometimes I do wonder about heaven. When Christ returns and those who died and are raised up by Him, will we remember what we were doing a couple of minutes ago – just before we passed? Here is a joke that touches on the subject. "A cowboy appeared before St. Peter at the pearly gates. "Have you ever done anything of particular merit?" asked St. Peter. The cowboy offered; "On a trip to South Dakota, I came upon a gang of bikers who were threatening a young woman. I told them to leave her alone, but they wouldn't listen. So, I approached the largest biker and smacked him in the face, kicked his bike over, ripped out his nose ring, and threw it on the ground. I yelled, Now, back off all of you!"
