Fellowship Meal: Please join us for our fellowship meal today. We ask you bring a vegetarian dish to share.

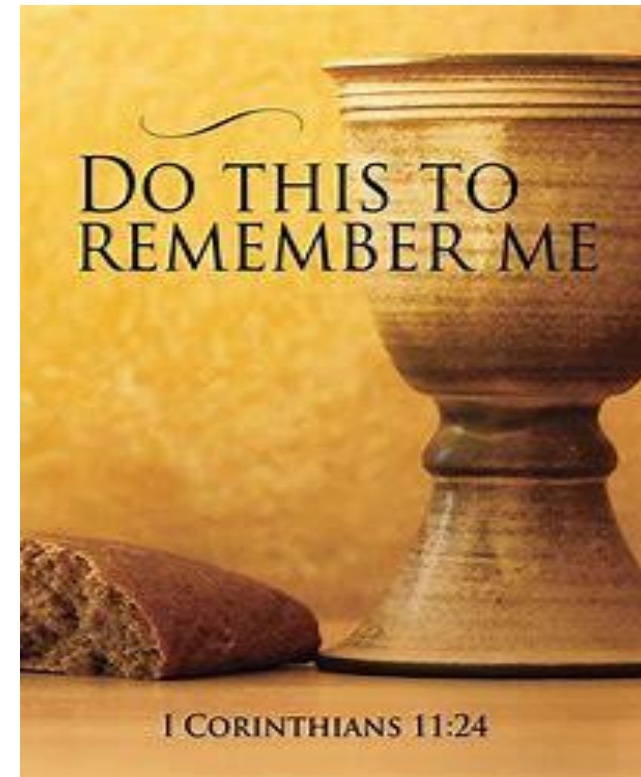
Brentwood Upcoming Events:
