**Pastor's Corner:** You can find all sorts of things on the social media platform. Some more true than others. I recently read something someone posted on Facebook. They equated attending a sporting event to attending church, but with one twist – it is from a pastoral perspective. It's heading reads "12 Reasons why I as a pastor have decided to quit attending sporting events." Here are the 12 reasons listed:

- 1. The coach never came to visit me.
- 2. Every time I went, they asked for money.
- 3. The people sitting in my row didn't seem very friendly.
- 1. The seats were very hard.
- 5. The referees made a decision I didn't agree with.
- 6. I was sitting with hypocrites—they only came to see what others were wearing!
- 7. Some games went into overtime, and I was late getting home.
- 8. The band played some songs I had never heard before.
- 9. The games are scheduled on my only day to sleep in and run errands.
- 10. My parents took me to too many games when I was growing up.
- 11. Since I read a book on sports, I feel that I know more than the coaches, anyway.
- 12. I don't want to take my children because I want them to choose for themselves what sport they like best.

Maybe you can draw a correlation between some of these points and your own worship experience but remember, going to church should never sound like a chore. Coming together with other like-minded believers on a Sabbath is an expression of your personal worship experience during the week. How you relate to God during the week will be on display for others to see when you come to the house of the Lord to worship on Sabbath. Philippians 2 talks about the mind of Christ, and we are called to have the same mindset, v.3-5 "Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better them himself. Let each of you look out not only for his own interest, but also for the interests of others... Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus." This should be the mindset that should be on display when you worship on Sabbath.


